In six years, the Bjarke Ingels Group will realize the most expensive commercial construction project in Warsaw.

The most expensive commercial construction project was announced in Warsaw, but somehow the news got lost. It's not just the big sum of three billion zloty. It is also 630,000 square meters to be planned as a mixed-use area with retail, culture, restaurants, hotel, museums and apartments. Danish architectural firm BIG focused on the neighborhood's past for this project. To tie in with the history, the architects want to revitalize former street routes. Wronia Street, for example, will be restored to its former course and will regain its former splendor with a roof made of glass.
